Score	Description
9	The student has fully functional commands in the language: proper, accurate and fluent with a complete understanding.
8	The student has fully functional commands in the language, with only occasional unsystematic inaccuracies. In unfamiliar situations, misunderstandings can occur. Handles complex and detailed discussions well.
7	The student has sufficient language command, but the language can be inaccurate, inappropriate, or misunderstood in some situations. In general, it handles complex languages well and understands detailed discussions.
6	Despite some inaccuracies and misunderstandings, the student generally has effective commands for the language. It can be understood using relatively complex languages, especially in familiar situations.
5	The student has partial command of the language, coping with overall meaning in most situations, though is likely to make many mistakes. In this sense, the student should be capable of communicating in familiar situations.
4	Basic competence is limited to familiar situations. The student often struggles to understand and/or convey meanings in most situations. The student cannot use complex languages
3	The student can communicate and understand only the general meaning in very familiar situations. Communication is frequently lost.
2	In familiar situations, real communication is not possible except for the simplest information that uses a single word or a short expression to meet an urgent need. The student is very difficult to understand spoken and written English.
1	The student essentially has no ability to use the language.
